Kenton is one of the world's leading mountaineers, with a deep love for the big mountains. He's climbed extensively around the world, including rock faces and peaks in Europe, Asia, and the Americas. His mountaineering achievements are virtually unparalleled - astonishing considering that he was told that he would never walk unaided again after a serious climbing accident in Wales in his early twenties.

In May 2022, Kenton summited Mount Everest for the 16th time, a non-Sherpa record and an achievement that gained worldwide media coverage.
