# Residential opportunities overview



### Year 7 | Château Beaumont, France Trip code: 2526041

This five-day Modern Languages-led trip to Château Beaumont combines cultural discovery with adventure. Students will visit Fougères Castle, Mont Saint-Michel, Saint-Malo, Gontier Market, and Laval Town and Museum, alongside on-site activities at the château. The trip concludes with a visit to Arromanches and the D-Day Landing Museum.

Year 8 | Exmoor Trip code: 2526024

A four-day Geography-led residential at the Pinkery Outdoor Education Centre in Exmoor National Park.
Students will explore Cornham Mines, complete river fieldwork, and enjoy activities such as climbing at the Valley of the Rocks, a coastal walk, bushcraft, orienteering, low ropes, and a campfire evening.

# **Year 7 | Château Beaumont, France**

This residential combines cultural discovery with adventure, giving students the chance to explore historic French towns and landmarks while developing confidence, independence, and teamwork skills.


### **Key details:**

# Year 8 | Exmoor

We are excited to offer our Year 8 students the chance to experience an unforgettable four-day Geography-led adventure in the heart of **Exmoor National Park**, staying at the **Pinkery Outdoor Education Centre**.

Students will explore the area's rich geography and history with a visit to Cornham Mines, a climbing session at the Valley of the Rocks, and a coastal walk offering spectacular views. They'll also be heading to the river at Cornham Mines to carry out geography fieldwork in the water, where they'll measure infiltration rates, flow velocity, and other key river features - so wellies are a must!



This adventurous and rewarding experience offers students the chance to develop independence, make lasting friendships, and create memories that will last a lifetime.



# **DofE Gold | Tarentaise Valley, France**

We are excited to offer our senior **Gold Duke of Edinburgh students** an extraordinary weeklong expedition to the **Tarentaise Valley** in the French Alps, taking place during Activities Week from 10th to 17th July. This challenging and rewarding residential combines adventure, skill development, and personal growth.

Students will take part in a 4-day expedition in the Alps, preceded by a 3-day seperate practice expedition in the Brecon Beacons to build confidence and competence in navigation, teamwork, and resilience. Additional activities include a high ropes course, white water rafting, and essential expedition training sessions. Meals during the Alps expedition and flights are included in the trip cost.

Information relating to all residential trips

- **Financial support:** If your child is a Pupil Premium student and you require financial assistance, please contact Mrs Shanks at <a href="mailto:kshanks@bournside.com">kshanks@bournside.com</a>.
- Oversubscribed trips: If a trip is oversubscribed, students' names will be drawn by ballot after the deadline has passed.
- **Behaviour and conduct:** All students attending residentials must sign a code of conduct. Mobile phone use will be limited, in line with our Smartphone-Free School policy. Students may be removed or banned from trips if their attendance or behaviour does not meet school expectations.
- **Payments:** Payments are non-refundable, unless a replacement student can be found for the booked place.
- **Safety and supervision:** All trip leaders are first-aid trained, and staff-to-student ratios follow national guidelines.
- International travel: For international trips, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that students hold a valid British passport and obtain a visa if required.
