Lesson Information

- **Duration**: 20 or 30 minutes
- **Timing**: During the school day on rotation (so the same lesson is not missed each week)
- **Structure**: 10 lessons per block (not always aligned with term dates)



Cost:

Prices vary per instrument and tutor, but on average, prices are: £14 for 20 minutes / £140 per block of ten £19 for 30 minutes / £190 per block of ten

• Payment: Direct to your child's tutor, usually in advance

Instruments

Students may use their own instrument, hire one from Gloucestershire Music, or from Jazz Shed in Charlton Kings (rent-to-buy scheme available). Some students may be entitled to a free loan instrument.
